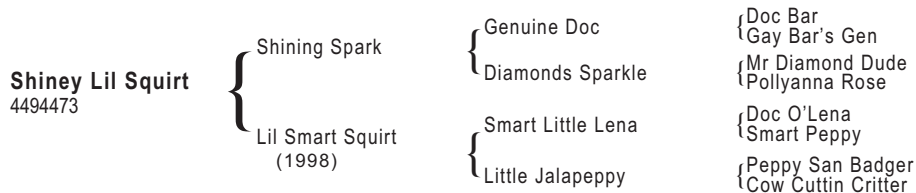


SHINEY LIL SQUIRT
